



SOMETHING'S DIFFERENT IN THE LAUNDRY ROOM.



Please read before doing your next load.

The laundry facilities in your building have recently been upgraded with new **high-efficiency** washers from Maytag. These new machines get your clothes cleaner, while saving lots of water and energy. They also work a little differently than traditional machines you're probably used to.

Here are the differences you need to know about:

Look for this symbol on your detergent container.

High-efficiency front-load machines wash best with specially formulated, low-sudsing HE detergent.

Use HE detergent **OR** use 1/4 of the recommended amount of any regular detergent that does not have the HE symbol.

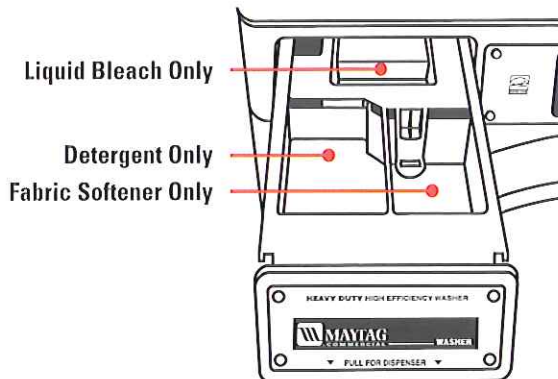

Pre-measure detergent.

Put additives in correct compartment.

Never put in additives after the cycle has started.



Smart controls adjust cycle times for soil levels, detergent levels, unbalanced loads and water pressure. You may see the display jump from 4 minutes to 0 minutes or stay on 1 minute for several minutes as it adjusts to that specific load condition.

Door will not open until cycle finishes.
Do not force door open.

You must load washer properly.

Do not overload machine.
Leave 5" of space at top.
